

Explanation of 2018 Australian Aid Stakeholder Survey results folder

This folder contains the results from the 2018 Australian Aid Stakeholder Survey, as well as some data from previous surveys (for the sake of examining trends in the data).

The 2018 survey report, which presents and explains the main results, can be found [here](#). Previous years' reports and data can be accessed at the same location.

The 'Combined dataset...' spreadsheet contains data for most of the questions from the survey. Its 'about' sheet explains its contents.

Each sub-folder in this results folder is dedicated to a group of questions. For example, the sub-folder 'Q12-14 Aid Purpose' contains the results for the three survey questions regarding the purpose of Australian aid. The sub-folders are named after question numbers and the subjects covered in the questions. The questions that generated the data in each sub-folder can be read in full in the survey questions file in this folder.

Within each sub-folder there is a spreadsheet containing the 2018 data from the relevant question/s. Where a time series is possible, it also contains data from previous year/s. Each spreadsheet also contains an 'about' sheet, which explains the contents of the spreadsheet. Usually, in addition to the data sheet we also have a 'codebook' sheet, which explains the variables, and other sheets containing pivot tables and charts summarising the data. Some of the charts in the report were produced in Stata, these charts are included in their respective folders as PDF files.

The 'Qs Attribute comparisons' folder is different to the others, it contains tables and charts comparing responses to questions on aid program attributes. Comparisons are made between different types of respondent, and between different survey years.
