
AUSTRALIAN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN INDONESIA

Second largest program

\$326m Official Development Assistance 2023-24

Sectors: Governance, Economic
Infrastructure, Agriculture, Trade,
Education, Health

Implementing partners: Contractor (63%), Multilateral (16%)




35 investments,

\$ 58m size




AUSTRALIAN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM IN INDONESIA: EFFECTIVENESS AND EFFICIENCY

Gradual increasing trend over years showing promising improvement



ANNUAL ONGOING VS FINAL RATINGS

Alternated ripple pattern for annual ongoing vs final ratings, but both are consistent at the top 20%



WHAT FACTORS CONTRIBUTE TO PERFORMANCE

- Effort to implement good practice program management throughout the program lifecycle
- Familiarity to quality reporting process and expectations
- Shared common understanding and performance expectations among three roles in the performance system



WHAT CHALLENGES WE ENCOUNTER

 Different investment type has different level of challenges, different level of expectations

E.g. grant to non-commercial vs service procured from commercial contractors

- Investment with **complex design**: consolidation of diverse activities and partners lack of coherence
- Investment delivers indirect support to changes difficult to define attribution and measure impact

 - > investments delivered by non-commercial partners
 - > Investments at design and the start-up phase
- Ensure **continuous learning** occurred along the program implementation:
 - > quality reporting,
 - regular monitoring
 - mid-term review
