Potentially identify difficult sectors

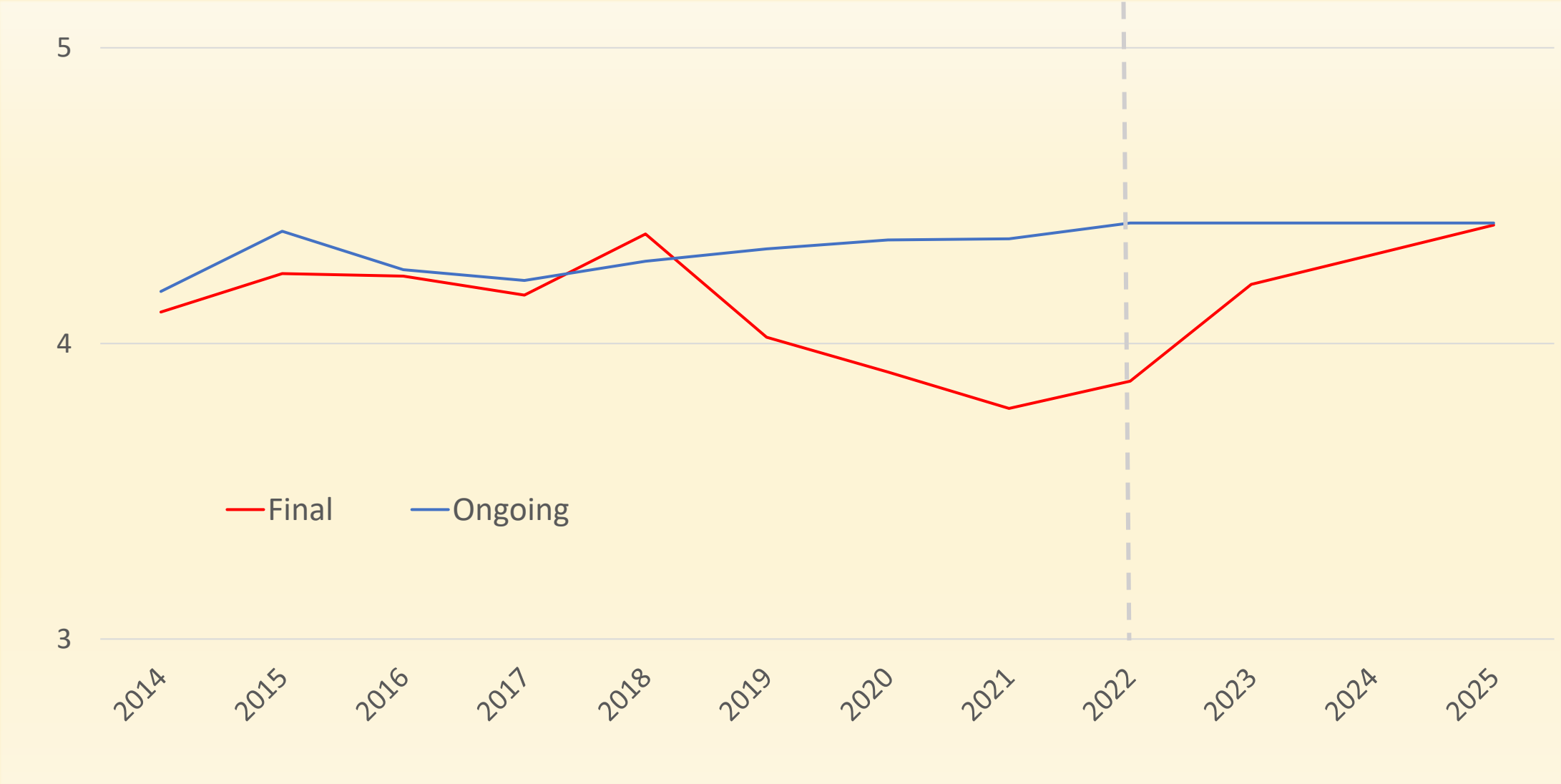
Potentially identify problematic modalities

Potentially identify procedural issues

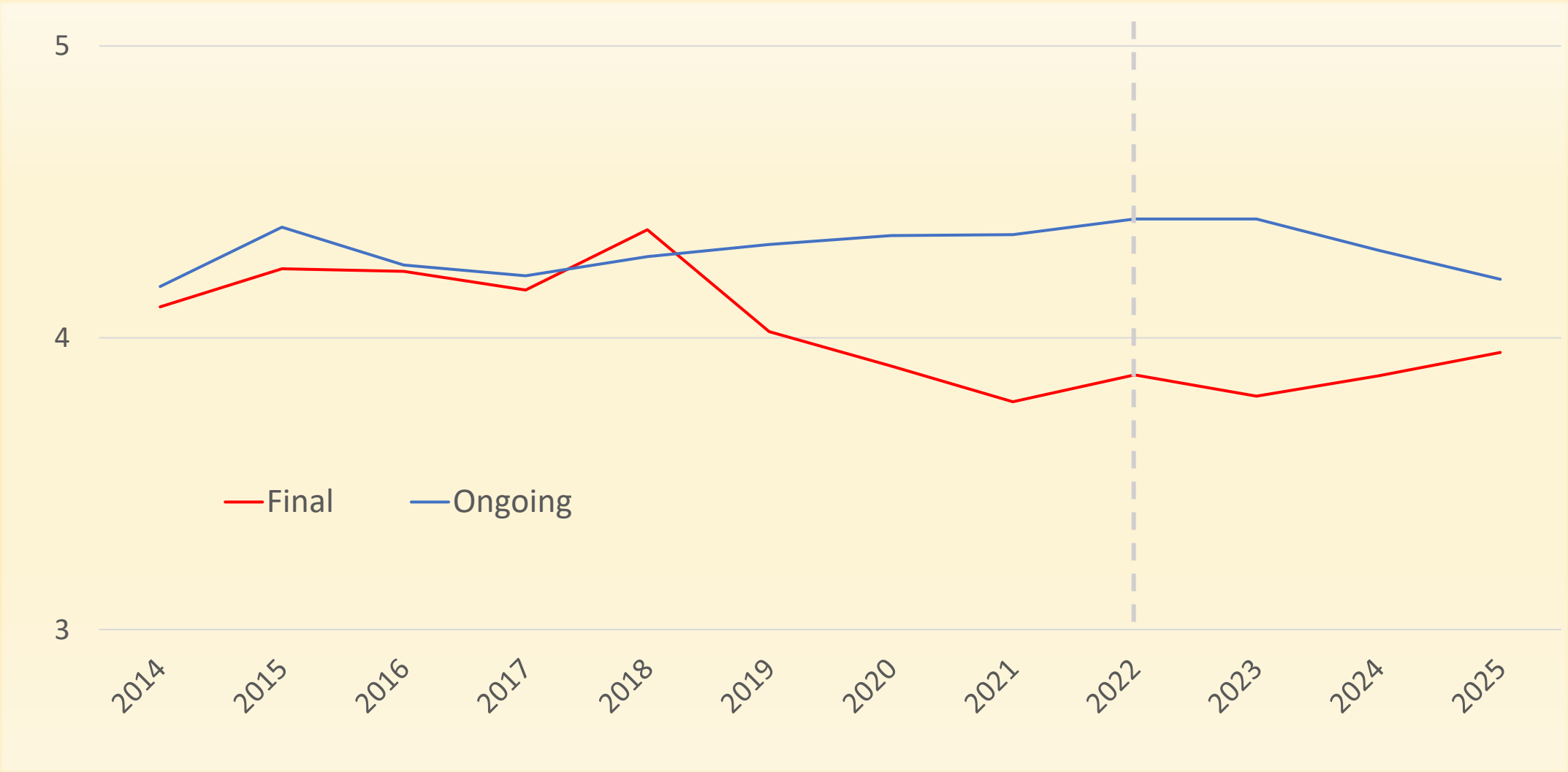
