12 May 2015; 6.8 Magnitude; 12:50 AM Kathmandu time



Over 8,700 lives perished; around 22,000 injured





8 million people affected,
including 5.3 million in 14 highly affected districts



At least 1 million children
are in urgent needs of humanitarian assistance

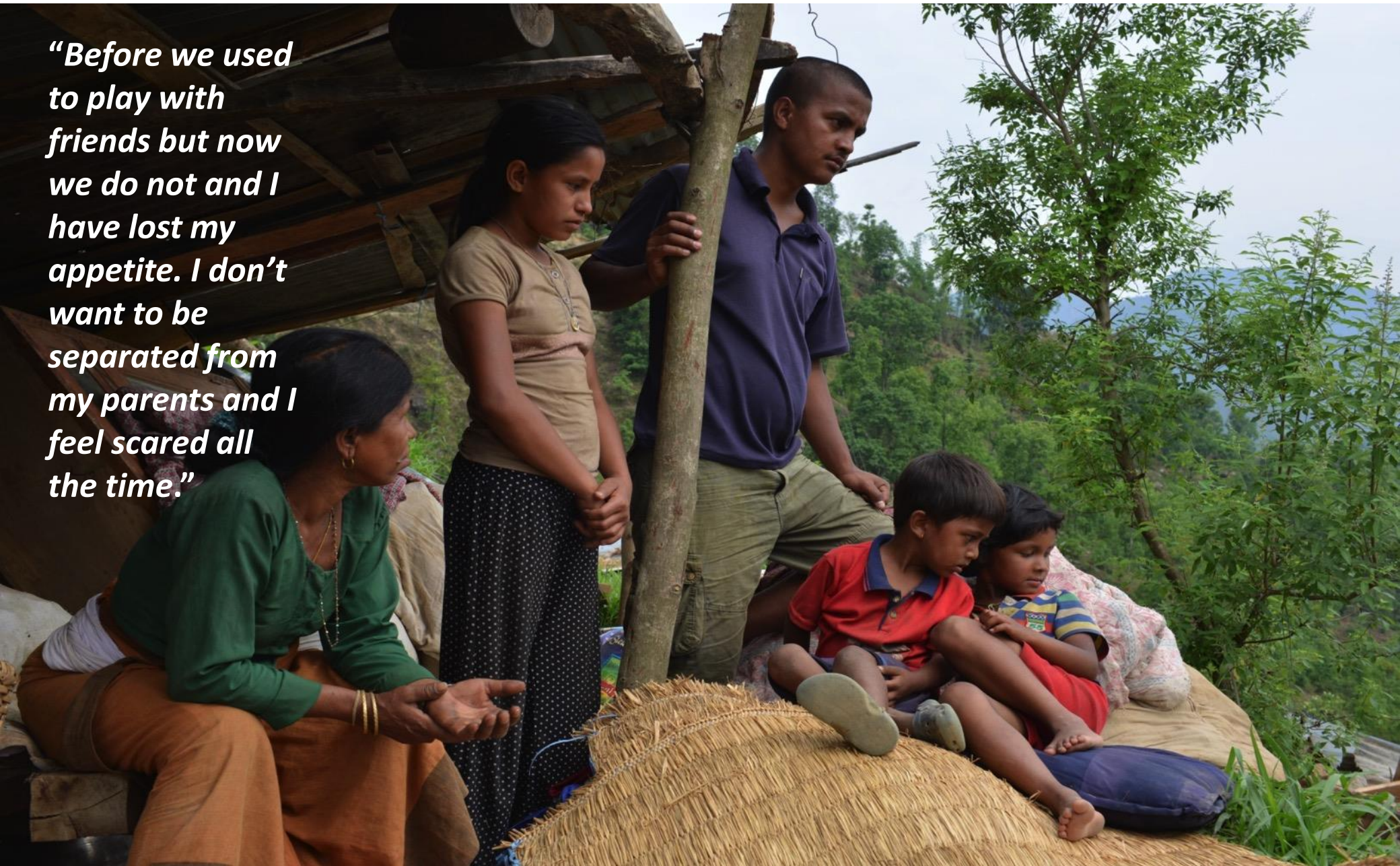
What children were saying...

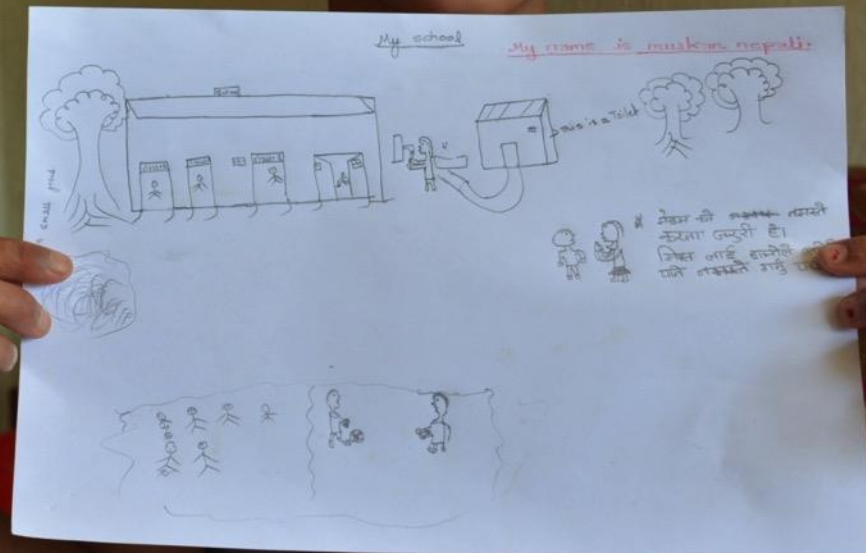

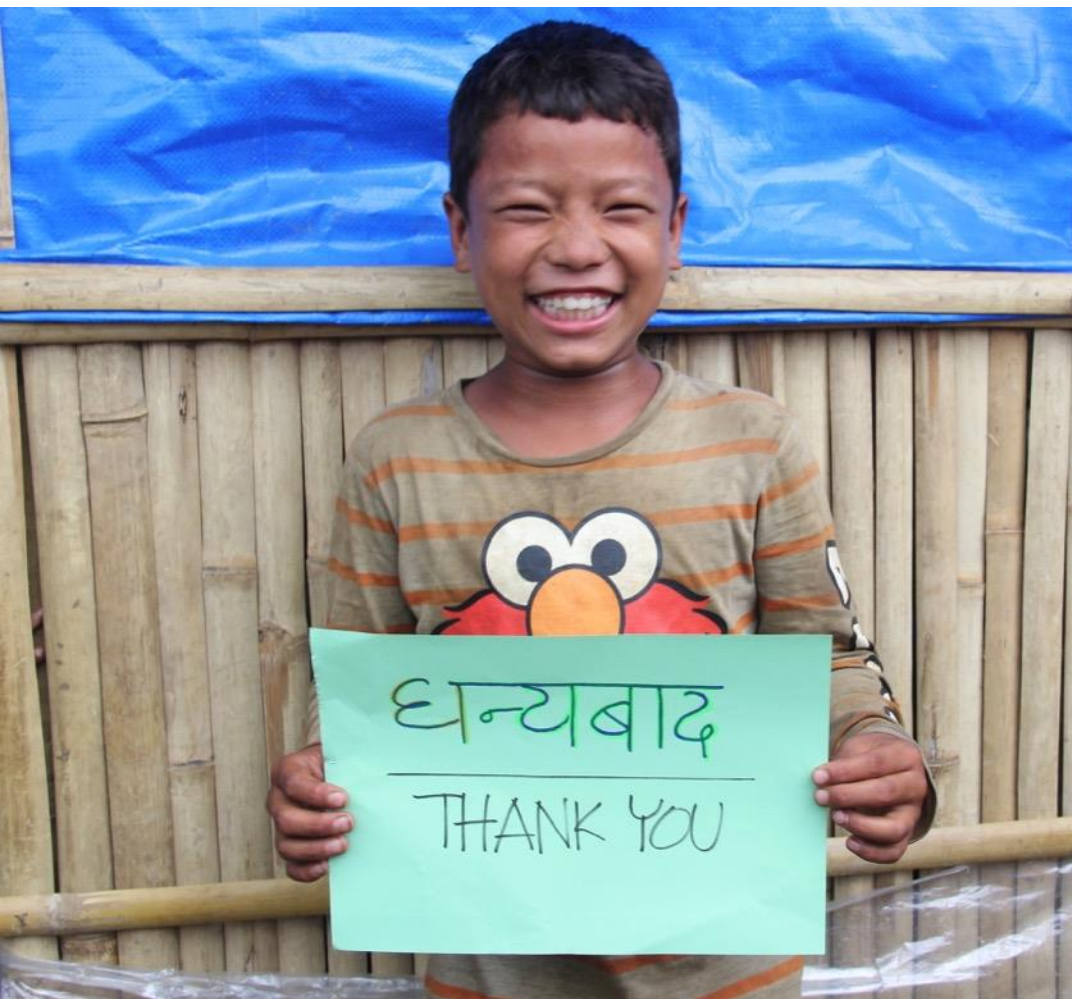
