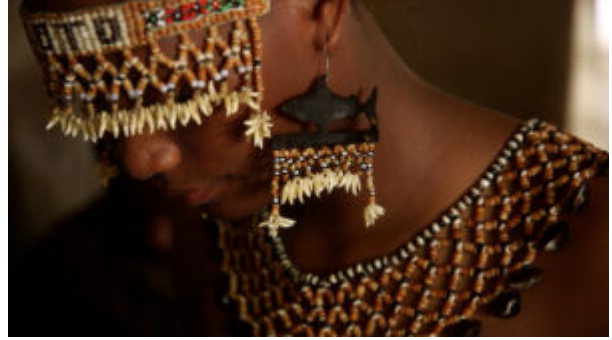


Clive Moore's Solomon Islands bibliography
